



Terms and conditions of use

Application and entire agreement

These terms and conditions apply between you, the User of this Website (including any sub-domains, unless expressly excluded by their own terms and conditions), and The County Wedding Clubs, the owner and operator of this Website.

Please read these terms and conditions carefully, as they affect your legal rights. Your agreement to comply with and be bound by these terms and conditions is deemed to occur upon your first use of the Website. If you do not agree to be bound by these terms and conditions, you should stop using the Website immediately.

In these terms and conditions, User or Users means any third party that accesses the Website and is not either (i) employed by The County Wedding Clubs and acting in the course of their employment or (ii) engaged as a consultant or otherwise providing services to The County Wedding Clubs and accessing the Website in connection with the provision of such services.

You must be at least 18 years of age to use this Website. By using the Website and agreeing to these terms and conditions, you represent and warrant that you are at least 18 years of age.

Intellectual property and acceptable use.

1. All content included on the Website, unless uploaded by Users, is the property of The County Wedding Clubs, our affiliates or other relevant third parties. In these terms and conditions, content means any text, graphics, images, audio, video, software, data compilations, page layout, underlying code and software and any other form of information capable of being stored in a computer that appears on or forms part of this Website, including any such content uploaded by Users. By continuing to use the Website you acknowledge that such content is protected by copyright, trademarks, database rights and other intellectual property rights. 17. The County Wedding Clubs accepts no liability for any disruption or non-availability of the Website.
18. The County Wedding Clubs reserves the right to alter, suspend or discontinue any part (or the whole of) the Website including, but not limited to, any products and/or services available. These terms and conditions shall continue to apply to any modified version of the Website unless it is expressly stated otherwise.

Limitation of liability

19. Nothing in these terms and conditions will: (a) limit or exclude our or your liability for death or personal injury resulting from our or your negligence, as applicable; (b) limit or exclude our or your liability for fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation; or (c) limit or exclude any of our or your liabilities in any way that is not permitted under applicable law.
20. To the extent that the Website and Content are provided free of charge, we will not be liable to you for any loss or damage of any kind.
21. We will not be liable to you in respect of any losses arising out of events beyond our reasonable control.
22. To the maximum extent permitted by law, The County Wedding Clubs accepts no liability for any of the following:
 - a. any business losses, such as loss of profits, income, revenue, anticipated savings, business, contracts, goodwill or commercial opportunities;
 - b. loss or corruption of any data, database or software;
 - c. any special, indirect or consequential loss or damage.

Payment and Payment Plans

23. Client understands the cost of The CWC community is payable monthly, in the amount of sixty or one hundred and twenty pounds (£60/£120), or annually, in the amount of seven hundred and twenty or one thousand four hundred and forty Pounds (£720/£1440) and charged automatically by month or year, in accordance with the Auto-Renewal Terms outlined below in paragraph five (5).
24. Client understands he/she is responsible for the full payment each month or year, and agrees to pay the sum requested electronically, via The County Wedding Clubs' website or a designated third-party payment processor of The County Wedding Clubs' choosing, in full. If Client has joined The CWC community during a promotional period and has been promised a trial period that is less than the amount outlined above, Client understands that after such trial period, the monthly amount due and payable will be £60/£120 per month, or £720/£1440 per year.
25. Client understands he/she is responsible for a joining fee, facilitating the technical support and administration requirements of getting a creative "LIVE" on the Website. These fees are £150 basic, £259 intermediate or £450 VIP. These services range from DIY basics to VIP full service joining. These fees will be charged in full upon joining.
26. Should Client fail to make timely payments, or if additional payments are not able to be processed, Client understands Client's access to The CWC community may be restricted if payment is not made within 1 day of the date it is due. If payment is not made on the date it is due, The County Wedding Clubs will continue to attempt to charge Client via the membership site software; if and when payment goes through, Client will again receive full access to the membership site.
27. If payment is not collected, Client's access will remain restricted, and Client will carry a balance on her account, showing the month(s) owed. Client must bring her account completely current in order to be granted access. If payment continues to be unsuccessful after sixty (60) days, Client membership shall be revoked and permanently cancelled. Should Client wish to re-join The CWC community, after this period, she must do so at the current price membership is being offered.
28. The County Wedding Clubs reserves the right to cancel Client's access to The CWC community should he/she fail to make additional payments in accordance with the Auto-Renewal Terms as outlined below. Should this occur, Client understands she is not entitled to a refund of funds already issued to The County Wedding Clubs for access to The CWC community.

Pausing membership

29. Client may elect to "pause" membership one (1) time throughout membership, by following these procedures:
30. Email hello@thecountyweddingclubs.co.uk with your one-time request to "pause" membership more than two (2) business days prior to Client's scheduled billing date. If approved, Client will not be charged for the following two (2) consecutive months only. Client may request one (1) additional pause of two (2) months by emailing the above email address again, for a total of four (4) months, before membership will automatically begin again.
31. If Client cannot make payments following this four (4) month pause, Client must cancel membership to avoid being charged.
32. If Client fails to request an additional two (2) month pause with two (2) business days' notice and is charged after the initial 2 months pause, this amount may not be refunded or cancelled. Client must request the pause prior to the billing date in order to receive consideration for a membership pause.

Auto-Renewal Agreement

33. Client understands and agrees that continued access to The CWC community requires recurring monthly payments of £60/£120 per month, or recurring year payments of £720/£1440 per year, that will be made by Client on the day of the month or year on which they signed up. (For example, if Client joins The CWC community on the 5th of the month via monthly membership, they will continue to be charged on the 5th of every month thereafter.)
34. If Client elects to be charged monthly: by purchasing access to The CWC community, and agreeing to these Terms of Use, Client understands he/she will be automatically charged each month, in the amount of £60/£120 per month via the same card or manner in which the initial payment was made, for the following month of membership to The CWC community. This process will repeat each month unless and until Client properly cancels his or her membership.
35. If Client elects to be charged annually: by purchasing access to The CWC community, and agreeing to these Terms of Use, Client understands he/she will be automatically charged each year, in the amount of £720/£1440 via the same card or manner in which the initial payment was made, for the following year of membership to The CWC community. This process will repeat each year unless and until Client properly cancels his or her membership.

Cancellation policy

36. If Client wishes to cancel his or her membership, Client must do so more than 48 hours before the charge is scheduled to withdraw. Any requests for cancellation made less than 48 hours before the automatic renewal is scheduled to charge Client's card, or made subsequent to the charge, will take effect the following month.
37. HOW TO CANCEL: In order to cancel a membership, Client must send an e-mail to hello@thecountyweddingclubs.co.uk with the subject line MEMBERSHIP CANCELTION, including the Client's name, email address, and confirmation of request to terminate his or her membership. Client will be notified upon The County Wedding Clubs' receipt of email, and his or her membership will subsequently be cancelled prior to the following billing period, assuming it is more than 48 hours away.
38. As outlined above, if Client cancels his or her membership less than 48 hours before the automatic renewal is scheduled to charge Client's card, Client acknowledges and agrees he or she will be charged for the next month, and the cancellation will take effect following this.
39. If Client purchased access to The CWC community during a period in which a free month(s), or trial period was granted, Client understands he or she will be automatically charged the full monthly amount of £35 following the end of the trial period. Client will not be given any additional notice regarding the end of the trial period, by checking the box on the purchase page confirming your agreement to these Terms, you also confirm you are given your unequivocal, clear, affirmative consent to your agreement with these automatic renewal terms, the cancellation policy, and that you understand how to cancel before your card is charged for the following month.

Refund Policy

40. The County Wedding Clubs is not able to offer refunds once Client has purchased access to The CWC community for any reason, including inability to obtain access to the site. If Client is dissatisfied with his or her membership or otherwise unable to view it in its entirety, he or she may reach out to customer service at hello@thecountyweddingclubs.co.uk or may elect to Cancel via the CANCELTION POLICY outlined above in paragraph six (6), and will not be charged for subsequent months.
41. Client further agrees and understands that changing his/her mind about The CWC community, failing to follow through or understand the details of The CWC community, not experiencing the results he/she expected or desired, or experiencing any other similar situations does not entitle her to a refund.

Technology

42. The County Wedding Clubs is not responsible for any specific technology you may need in order to adequately view and utilise The CWC community. Client's inability to access The CWC community due to a technology issue on Client's end does not qualify Client for a refund, nor does it alleviate Client of his or her responsibility to make monthly payments, unless or until Client's membership is properly cancelled in accordance with the cancellation policy in paragraph six (6).

Voluntary Participation

43. Client understands and agrees that he/she is voluntarily choosing to enrol in The CWC community and is solely responsible for any outcomes or results. While The County Wedding Clubs believes in the services and that The CWC community is able to help many people, Client acknowledges and agrees that The County Wedding Clubs is not responsible nor liable to Client should Client sustain any injuries, incur harm, or encounter any negative ramifications. Client agrees that he/she is fully responsible for his/her health and well-being, including participation in The CWC community and any results therein.
44. Client also understands she will have the opportunity to provide The County Wedding Clubs with additional personal information, viewable to all The CWC community members, including but not limited to location, industry, and other information. All information is completely voluntary and optional to complete, and Client does not gain or lose anything in The CWC community for choosing to complete or not complete the additional information. Client understands this information will only be viewable to others inside The CWC community, and understands that should he/she elect to complete the information, he/she is doing so completely voluntarily, and that The CWC community and The County Wedding Clubs are not responsible for any negative results from such information dissemination.

Disclaimer /No Guarantees

45. While many of The County Wedding Clubs' past and current clients have experienced wonderful benefits from the content contained in The CWC community, The County Wedding Clubs cannot guarantee results from any of the content on The CWC community, and cannot make any representations or guarantees regarding individual results. Client will hold The County Wedding Clubs harmless if he or she does not experience the desired results.
46. Client understands that all services provided by The CWC community and The County Wedding Clubs in connection with The CWC community being purchased are provided on an "as is" basis, meaning it is without any guarantees, representations, or warranties, including but not limited to warranties relating to quality, non-infringement, fitness for a particular purpose, merchantability, or expectation or course of performance. Client is choosing to purchase access to The CWC community and work with The County Wedding Clubs on a purely voluntary basis and does not hold The County Wedding Clubs or The CWC community responsible should Client become dissatisfied with any portion of The CWC community.
47. Client agrees that he/she does not have a cause of action, legal remedy, and is not entitled to a refund should he/she not achieve the results desired following completion of The CWC community, as long as The County Wedding Clubs delivers The CWC community as described in the Addendum below.
48. Client also agrees to hold The County Wedding Clubs harmless should any physical, emotional, or financial injury occur as a direct or indirect result of The CWC community. The content provided by The County Wedding Clubs on its website and within The CWC community is comprised of information that has worked for The County Wedding Clubs and other clients, and may or may not be useful to Client in his/her personal business or life. Client understands The County Wedding Clubs cannot guarantee results from this The CWC community, and has no expectation of a specific result that he or she holds The County Wedding Clubs responsible for.
49. Client also understands he or she is purchasing The CWC community and participating freely and voluntarily. The information contained within The CWC community may not be suitable for all persons and all business levels, and Client understands he or she may need to modify, edit, or change some of the educational lessons within The CWC community in order to make it applicable to Client's business.

Not Medical or Professional Advice:

52. If unable to reach a resolution informally, Client and The County Wedding Clubs agree that all disputes will be submitted for Arbitration, to be completed in Law of England and Wales within a reasonable amount of time. Client and The County Wedding Clubs agree to participate in the arbitration process in good faith and in a manner that will effectively and efficiently resolve the dispute at hand, including the exchange of any materials, documents, or information. General

59. This Agreement shall be governed by and interpreted according to the law of England and Wales and all disputes arising under the Agreement (including non-contractual disputes or claims) shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English and Welsh courts.

Amendments

63. This agreement is not to be altered, amended, changed, extended, or considered waived without execution of an additional addendum signed by both Client and The County Wedding Clubs, or a party authorised to sign on behalf of either party.

The CWC community membership outline addendum

64. Client understands, acknowledges, and agrees he/she is purchasing a monthly subscription to The CWC community. While the below is subject to change, at the time of purchase, The CWC community includes access to the following:
 - a. The County Wedding Clubs community membership, including all content and resources that have been created since inception of the Membership.
 - b. Monthly Success pillars, delivered each month containing trainings on various topics that have been deemed relevant to online business owners in the wedding industry, with corresponding handouts, workbooks, or other materials;
 - c. Mentoring Sessions once month lasting approximately one hour, amongst other offerings of online meetings.
 - d. Access to an exclusive Facebook community only for Community members.
 - e. Additional resources, guides, and services as created by The County Wedding Clubs.
